Escape to Colorado wine country, right here on the Front Range! Experience tasting and touring from our wonderfully diverse selection of Front Range wineries. Front Range vintners are known for producing a wide variety of premium wines, from rich Chardonnays, robust Merlots and crisp Rieslings to wines made from Colorado cherries, peaches, plums and honey. Use this guide to customize your own tour and sample the award-winning wines that have earned Colorado top honors in National and International wine competitions.

If your travels include Rocky Mountain National Park or the Estes Park area, be sure to visit the Northern winery region. Discover the eclectic and intriguing town of Boulder, just half an hour from downtown Denver. Turquoise Mesa, located in Broomfield, minutes from the 1st Bank Center and Flatirons Mall, serves award-winning wines, including reds, whites and blends. Continuing on, stop at BookCliff Vineyards to taste 100% Colorado grown wines and then hop next door for some beer at the UpSlope Brewing Company. Try the

unique taste of "honey wine" or mead, over at the Redstone Meadery. Boulder's latest offering, Settembre Cellars, crafts old-world styled wines from 100% Colorado grapes. Boulder Creek Winery, located one mile from Celestial Seasonings



Denver offers a broad spectrum of varietals from Merlot and Sangiovese to Muscat and Port. For a taste of wine made in the "old-world" traditions brought over from Italy, cruise over to Spero Winery. Making your way through downtown, stop in at Tewksbury & Co. tasting room for a

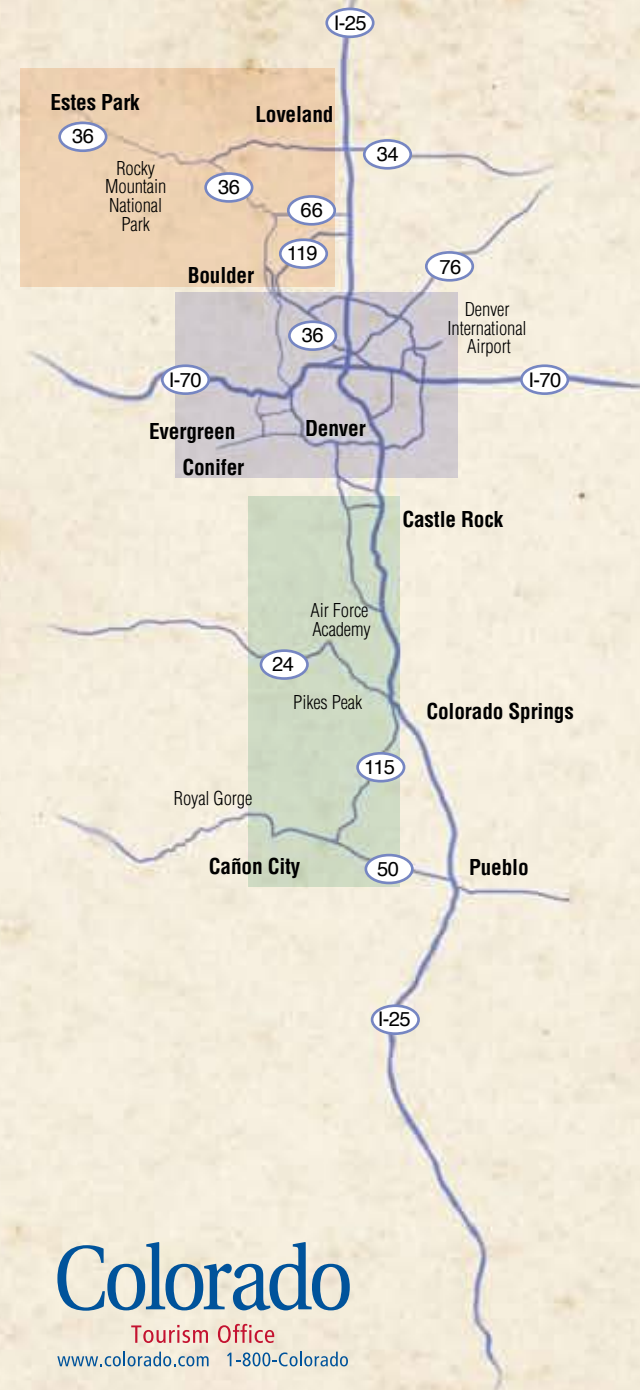
the deck and enjoy fine wine paired with delicious global fare from their restaurant, while enjoying the rippling waters of Bear Creek. Cap off your day a little farther south in Conifer, experience Aspen Peak Cellars, an inviting combination of winery with a bed and breakfast.

If the Colorado Springs area attractions are on your list, then check out the Southern winery region. Heading south out of Denver, visit Allis Ranch Winery. Allis Ranch Winery is a family owned boutique winery, built in a 1910 Sears Catalogue house. Traveling further South, a "must-see" is the Winery at Holy Cross Abbey. Truly a unique setting on the pastoral grounds of a historic Monastery

sampling of wines from Plum Creek Winery and fine cigars. Head a little southwest toward the foothills to Denver's latest offering, Dithyramb producing Colorado wines and meads. Further West, check out Avanti Winery in Littleton where you can sample many Colorado premium wines and cigars.
